Initiation Fees, Membership Dues and Capital Assessment Fees and any other costs and assessments are non-refundable flat-rate fees and are not prorated for any purpose whatsoever.

Applicants must submit their applications by email to the Membership Director at membership@peachlandyachtclub.ca. Make payment via e-transfer to payments@peachlandyachtclub.ca or make your cheque, money order, or bank draft payable to Peachland Yacht Club. Applications for Membership will only be processed upon receipt of full payment. If your application is approved, a copy of this form will be returned to you with additional details.

One Membership is defined as a person who has attained the age of 19 and may include a spouse and children under 19 years of age. Specifically, children under the age of nineteen (19) are considered members under their parents' Membership. Upon attaining the age of nineteen (19), children wishing to retain their Membership must renew their own Membership at regular Membership rates. The initiation fee will be waived for these dependents only if they continue their Membership at age 19 and not later. Children who are already over the age of nineteen (19) at the time of their parents' application and Membership are not considered members and must apply for their own regular Membership. All other family members or friends would need to become members to operate a boat on the marine or use a PYC gate fob/smart phone access. Membership is not transferable in any way, including and not limited to adult children, relatives, friends or co-owners of a boat. Only moorage Members may operate a vessel within the marina.

MOORAGE:

PYC Marina is located at 5667 Beach Avenue, Peachland, B.C.(the 8th Street Marina). Fifty-nine (59) slips are available for:

- (a) Sailboats (minimum length 15 feet, maximum overall length 34 feet, maximum beam 11 feet)
- (b) Power boats (Outboard or Inboard/Outboard, 15-34 feet in length, max. beam 11 feet, minimum 40 hp)

All vessels must be moored in the marina by July 1 of each calendar/moorage year. The Club may, at its sole discretion, without notice, sublet any slip for any period after June 30 of a calendar/moorage year where the moorage Member has not occupied the slip assigned, and any and all fees paid by a moorage Member are on the account of the Club and are not refundable in any manner for any reason whatsoever. If the moorage member has any amount outstanding due to the Club, moorage may be suspended until all fees, fines, assessments, and any and all costs are paid to the Club. For greater certainty, sublet fees in any and all circumstances are on account of the Club; moorage Members have no right, privilege or any other benefit from sublet fees received by the Club. The Club may, acting reasonably and in its sole discretion, void a moorage Member's moorage contract where a moorage Member does not comply with these terms and conditions. If the Club exercises this discretion, the Member shall be removed as a moorage Member and be placed at the bottom of the Wait List.

PYC does not offer moorage for houseboats, pontoon boats, twin-hull boats, personal watercraft, or car-top boats such as canoes, kayaks or aluminum fishing boats. Thru-transom exhaust systems must have a Captain's Call switch. Moorage is managed by the Fleet Captain and is filled from the Wait List based on "Next in Line". When permanent, sublet or day moorage becomes available, Members are required to complete the Moorage Contract and provide proof of insurance (minimum \$3.0 million or industry standard), including insuring the vessel, salvage and clean-up costs, before occupying a slip in the marina. If the boat that a Member owns or is contemplating acquiring is an uncommon size, moorage will depend on:

- (a) Size and space availability;
- (b) Member's current moorage status and allocation; and
- (c) Confirmation of Annual Dues payment if on the Wait List. If space is not available for your size of boat, moorage may be delayed pending a vacancy in that size category. Your name remains on the Wait List Register.



PYC Membership Information 2026 – please keep this copy for your records.

Permanent Moorage:

- (a) A Qualified Wait List Member is **OBLIGED to accept PERMANENT moorage** when offered.
- (b) If a Qualified Wait List Member declines permanent moorage, the Member's current rank on the Wait List will be forfeited, and the Member will be moved to the bottom of the list.

Sublet Moorage:

- (a) A qualified Wait List Member **is not OBLIGED to accept TEMPORARY moorage** when offered.

Daily Moorage:

- (a) At times, Moorage members may need to remove their boats from the Marina for repairs or other reasons.
- (b) If daily moorage becomes available due to a temporary vacancy, the Fleet Captain may offer it to Wait List members who have a boat that will fit the berth, based on "next in line".
- (c) The Executive will set the rate for daily moorage rental.

GUEST MOORAGE AT OTHER YACHT CLUBS:

Any Member planning to visit other valley yacht clubs by water, please contact the other yacht club ahead of time to make arrangements. Proof of moorage and liability insurance will be required.

GATE FOBS/SMART PHONE ACCESS:

A **Member** in good standing is eligible for a Gate Fob/smartphone access for access to the Marina.

- (a) A deposit of \$30.00 per fob (maximum 2 per family) is required and will be refunded provided that the Gate fob is surrendered, **undamaged**, to the PYC Fleet Captain at the above address within 30 days of cancellation of Membership. Failure to apply for a refund and surrendering an undamaged fob within 30 days will result in the deposit being forfeited to the PYC.
- (b) **Gate fobs and smartphone access are not transferable** or shared and are for Moorage Members' use only, as per the Gate Fob Contract.
